We are Requesting that you Register in Advance for Services, Study Sessions and other Programs

If you wish to participate either in-person or online, we are requesting that you complete a registration form **BY SEPTEMBER 5** (or later date noted below) indicating whether you want to participate and in what manner. If capacity limits are implemented and we receive more requests for in-person participation than can fit within our space limitations, then we may accept your household's in-person registration for fewer services, study sessions and other programs than you request. During registration, you can also participate in other ways during the High Holy Days: Rosh Hashanah Gift, Rosh Hashanah Lunch (register by **SEPTEMBER 5**), Movie Night Dinner (register by **SEPTEMBER 15**), Yom Kippur Break Fast (register by **SEPTEMBER 26**), or Sponsor Flowers for the Bimah.

How to Register for Services, Study Sessions and other Programs

- Complete and return the paper registration form which accompanied the High Holy Day mailing and which can also be found at www.shirathayamnantucket.org/worship/#high-holy-days/.

The registration form must be completed separately by each household. A 'household' is a group of people (family or friends) who are either sharing the same home or are part of a social circle in which all members gather in close contact. For each service, study session and other program that are available both in-person and online, you may register members of your household to all participate online or all participate in-person or some of each.

Confirming Your Participation

On September 12, we will contact you by email to do the following:

- Confirm which services, study sessions and programs you may join in-person; and
- Provide details to access online services and study sessions

In-Person Gatherings

All in-person gatherings will be guided by public health requirements and best practices in effect at the date of the applicable service or study session. At present,

- Out of consideration to others, we request that all participants conduct an at-home COVID test within 24 hours prior to attending in-person services or study sessions;
- Neither you, nor anyone else for whom you register, will attend a service or program if (1) recently tested positive for COVID-19; (2) subject to any quarantine or isolation requirements; (3) exposed recently to someone with COVID-19; or (4) feeling ill, including with any symptoms typically associated with COVID-19; and
- Mask-wearing is optional. To minimize the risk to you and to others, all participants – whether vaccinated or not – are encouraged to wear a mask throughout indoor in-person services or study sessions.

If any in-person gathering is not possible for any reason, we will contact you at the email address provided during registration.
